# The ABC's of Prayer

Because of our relationship with the Lord, we can pray specifically and with perseverance.

<sup>12</sup>For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. <sup>12</sup>Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account. <sup>14</sup>Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, <sup>16</sup> Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. <sup>16</sup>For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. <sup>16</sup>Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need. — Hebrews 4:12-16

### The ACTS of Praying!

Thanksgiving — Give God thanks for all blessings and in all circumstances.

Supplication — Ask God for guidance, discernment, and requests for family, others, and yourself.
